## **Algorithms**

The algorithms for risk assessment of patients presenting in primary care, <u>general practice</u> and <u>healthcare settings other than receiving hospitals</u>, <u>the National Ambulance Service</u> and at receiving hospitals have been updated

The main changes are as follows:

- Standard, contact and droplet precautions advised for all settings with airborne precautions for aerosol generating procedures
- Clarification that mainland China excludes Hong Kong and Macau
- Samples accepted for testing at NVRL now include nasopharyngeal and oropharyngeal swabs

## **Laboratory guidance**

The new guidance on novel coronavirus 2019-nCoV collection and transportation of specimens includes:

- Steps for sample collection and transportation to NVRL
- The need for both clinical and public health contact details to report results
- Testing will be performed once daily including at weekends
- Estimated turnaround time is 12-24 hours; for same day results samples must arrive at the NVRL before 10am
