How to Code a Disease and Retrieve Patients with that Disease Using CompleteGP



Open a new consultation and Select the Diagnosis Icon Δ or press the 'D' key.

Diagnoses should be coded using either ICPC-2 or ICD-10. If a diagnosis is not available in either of these coding tables a local can be created.

Click the appropriate coding system (most General Practice Diagnosis are ICPC-2).

You can enter a string to search for or you can use the category tree to locate the appropriate code.

Once you select the correct code, the details of the inclusion and exclusion criteria for using that code are displayed and also suggestions about other possible codings are displayed.

CompleteGP includes links to external Web Calculators and links to evidencebased information and practical 'know how' about the common conditions managed in primary care. If one of these exists in CompleteGP which matches the diagnosis code selected the link is also displayed and can be double-clicked to display the associated Calculator or Web resource.
