In this prospectus you will find key information on our vision for GP Training, our mission and values, together with the facts about the National GP Training programme, the process of recruitment to the programme and details on each of the Training schemes.

Since March 2021, ICGP has had sole responsibility for postgraduate specialist medical training in the specialty of General Practice. As part of this responsibility, the ICGP designs and delivers a world-class, highly innovative and continuously improving GP Training Scheme, as set out in the vision, mission and values statement.

There are currently 866 trainees enrolled on the GP Training Programme and we intend to increase our intake into training to over 250 in 2022. As you are probably aware there is a national shortage of GPs, and you will thus be joining a programme and specialty at a most exciting time with numerous opportunities awaiting you on completion of your training

As part of the national recruitment process, we have prepared a [guide to applicants](#) and we will host an online information session on Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> October 2021. We hope you can join us. I look forward to meeting you then.

### **The Irish College of General Practitioners:**

The Irish College of General Practitioners is the postgraduate training body (PGTB) responsible for postgraduate education, training and research in the specialty of General Practice. The College has a national advisory role in relation to medical standards and engages with the Medical Council, Department of Health and Children, the Health Service Executive and the Health Information & Quality Authority amongst others. As a membership organisation, the ICGP is responsible for providing and supporting the continuous professional development for general practitioners, numbering over 4,500. The ICGP is the PGTB accredited by the Medical Council to provide professional training for doctors wishing to enter the specialty of General Practice.

- Every patient and their community has access to a professional, committed, and holistic GP, who has the ability to respond to the physical, psychological, and social health needs of their patients and the communities in which they practise.

**Mission Statement**

- The mission of the training programme is to train doctors to be professional, competent, community-adaptive, and fulfilled GPs in an effective and equitable way that meets the current and future needs of patients, trainees, and the profession.

This will be done by providing an appropriate combination of workplace learning, taught elements, self-reflection, mentoring, and peer learning, in a variety of settings, to foster individual progression from novice to independent practitioner and instil habits of life-long learning.

Year 3 & 4	Based in supervised general practices with a nominated GP Trainer. 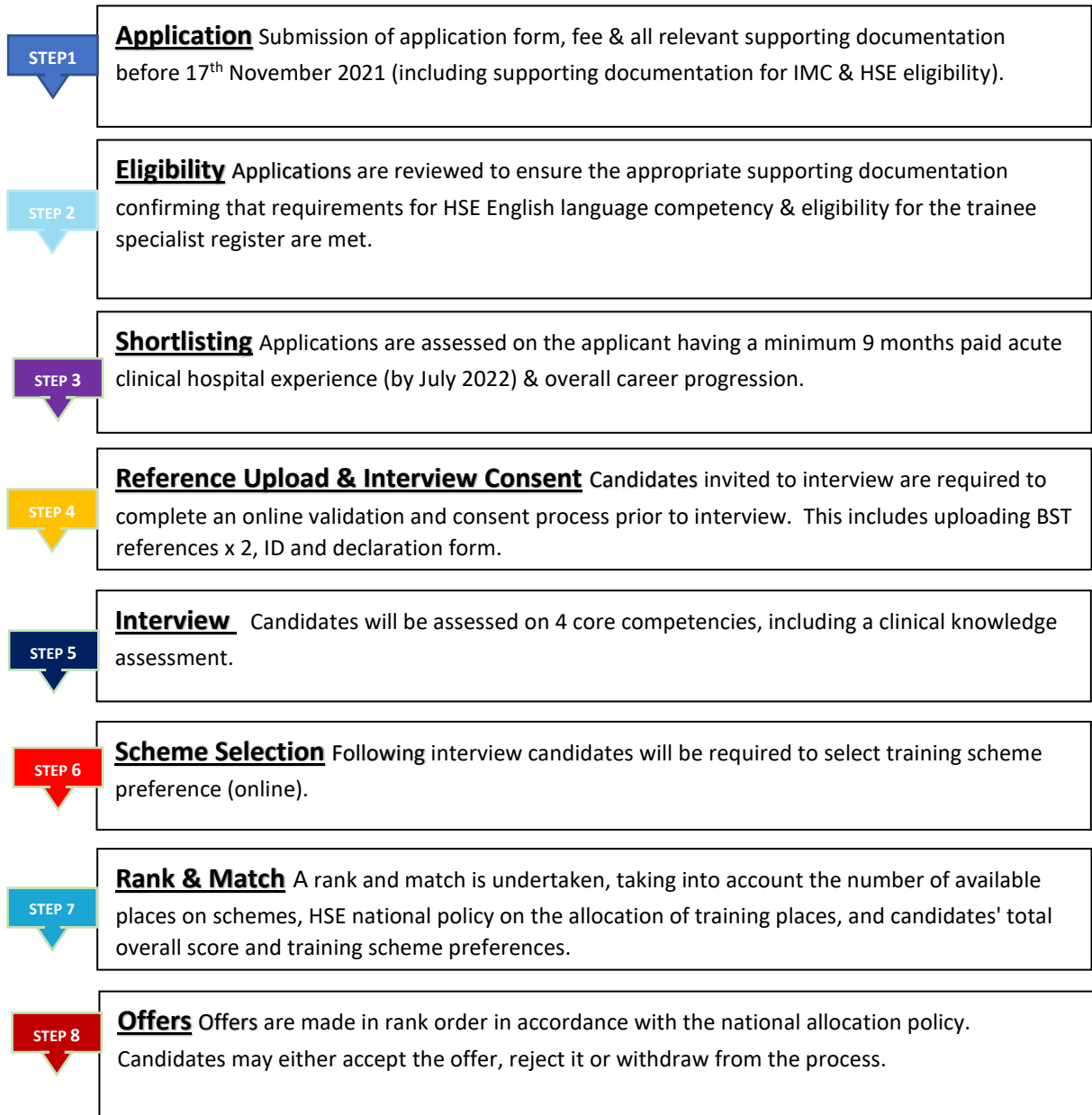


FACTS ABOUT THE GENERAL PRACTICE TRAINING PROGRAMME CONTINUED

Entrustable Professional Activities (EPAs)

Our training will continue to be Learner centered but innovative in its delivery. In developing and updating our training and assessment within ICGP there will be strong emphasis on Feedback for Learning. This will be driven by way of Entrustable Professional Activities (EPA's) which are drawn from the ICGP curriculum for training. Guided feedback which you actively seek from your Trainers makes your learning more efficient and allows you to demonstrate your professional and clinical growth. These EPA's will be digitally enabled using an App developed with the appropriate learning software. Your learning records, including ICGP EPA records, will be reviewed regularly with your educational supervisors to help you reach your goals.
