## **Terms & Conditions**

- 1. Members of the ICGP in good standing are eligible to enter this competition.
- 2. Applicants should be enrolled and in compliance with the ICGP PCS or enrolled in GP specialist training with the ICGP.
- 3. Entries must demonstrate improvements or innovations implemented in a general practice setting in Ireland.
- 4. Projects completed in 2023 or by the closing date in 2024 are eligible for submission.
- 5. All entries must be in typed format on the official application form.
- 6. The word count is provided on the application form and should not be exceeded.
- 7. Applications will be accepted via email only to <a href="mailto:qip@icgp.ie">qip@icgp.ie</a>
- 8. Application emails should have 'ICGP QSIP Awards 2023/2024' as the subject title.
- 9. Closing date for entries is Wednesday, 31st of July 2024 at 5pm
- 10. Finalists should be available to make a three-minute summary presentation on their submission at the ICGP Annual Conference which will be held in the Dublin Convention Centre on the 27<sup>th</sup> of September 2024 as part of the WONCA Europe Conference, where awards will be presented.
- 11. The ICGP retains copyright over all entries.
- 12. Submitted entry forms will not be returned so applicants should retain their own copy.
- 13. The decision of the judges is final, and they reserve the right not to make an award depending on the quality of submissions.
- 14. Entries submitted after the closing date will not be considered.
- 15. Projects previously submitted to an ICGP competition are not eligible.
- 16. By applying for a QSIP award, applicants are accepting the ICGP privacy policy.
